Angelina County Appraisal District Earns High Marks from Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts in First State Mandated Review

The Angelina County Appraisal District (ACAD) passed or exceeded every mandatory standard of evaluation established by the Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts who recently announced its findings for the district after an extensive review of the district's operations were ordered by state law.

The Texas Legislature now requires the Texas Comptroller to conduct a formal Methods and Assistance Program (MAP) review on a rotating schedule for every central appraisal district in Texas. The comprehensive review includes documentation and analysis of a district's compliance with state law. It also includes detailed review of a district's performance in four critical areas: governance, taxpayer assistance, operating procedures, and appraisal standards, procedures, and methodology.

The Texas Comptroller determined that ACAD had exceeded its standards in the four major categories cited above, earning its highest score in the category of taxpayer assistance. The taxpayers and jurisdictions of Angelina County should view this evaluation as an independent confirmation that ACAD remains dedicated to performing its constitutional and statutory duties in an efficient and fair way.
